

They were taught about the core values of leadershp:


GENEROSITY - Willingness to use what you have been given (time and resources) on behalf of those you seek to influence.

- Order and pay for uniforms and canteen items
- Sign & submit **permission note**s and see details of all excursions
- See regular news items on the parent dashboard
- See a calendar of events
- See your child/ren's Academic Reports and Personal Learning Pathways.

The **LPS Text** service is for quick messages and one to one communication. Here you can notify the school about last minute transport changes and ask questions. We also use text to remind you something is needing your attention in School Bytes.
